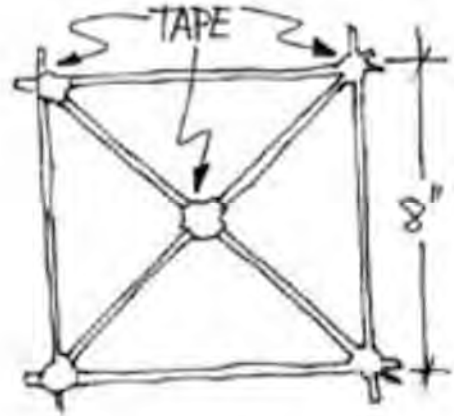
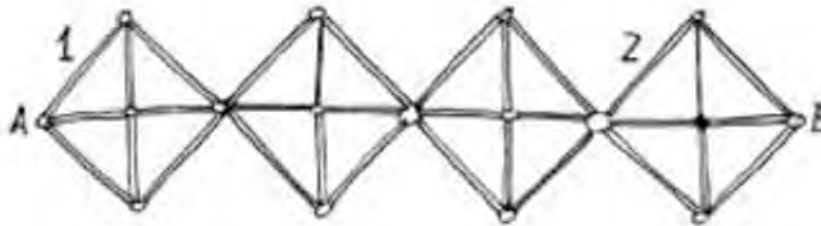


DIAMOND BOX LANTERN

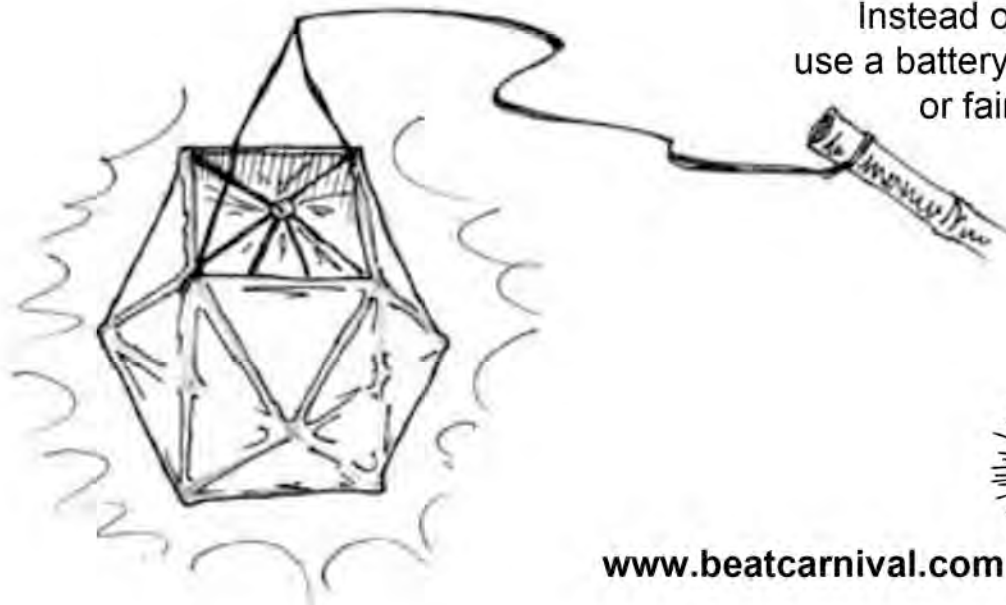
1. Start off by making six 8 inch squares, inserting a cross frame into all but one of them. For this lantern to work it is important for all these squares to be the same size. Use one withy as a standard side length and measure all the other sides against it for consistency.



2. Select one of your cross framed squares to be your base and attach your candle holder to it update – use battery light instead.
3. Tape the four remaining cross framed squares corner to corner as shown. Bring square 1 around to meet square 2 and tape corners A and B together to form an open diamond sided box.



4. Tape the bottom corner of each of these squares to the corners of your base and the top corners to those of the remaining square (the one without the cross frame).
5. Cover with tissue paper leaving the top open and an open panel near the base so you can light the candle.



UPDATE
Instead of a candle,
