

# Simple Pyramid Style

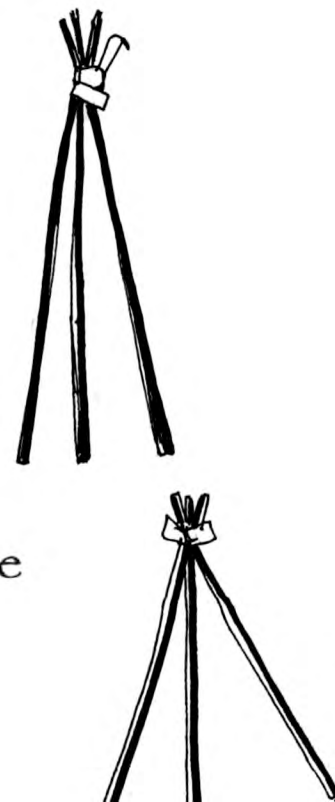
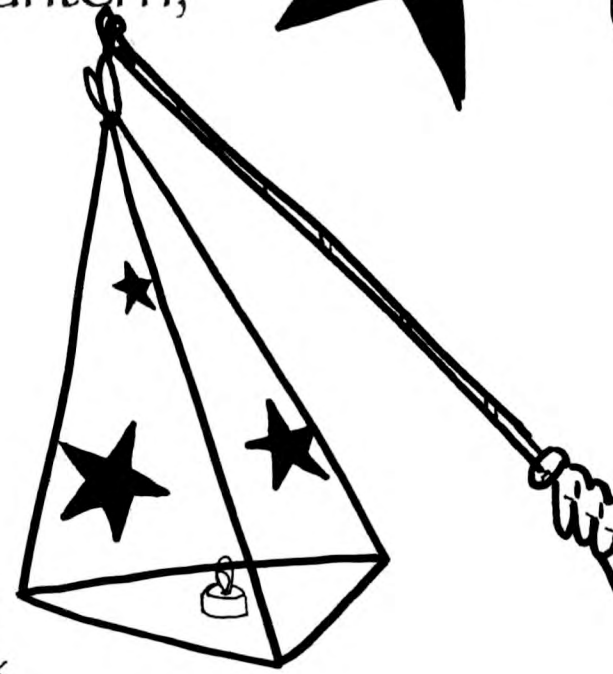
## Lanterns -- WORKSHEET --

What you will need to make lantern;

- \* Scissors
- \* 1 long stick to carry lantern
- \* 3 sticks cut to 30 cm
- \* 3 sticks cut to 15 cm
- \* 1 roll of masking tape
- \* 1 roll of cello-tape
- \* 1 roll of cling film wrap
- \* A piece of wire or twine
- \* A battery LED tea light or glow stick
- \* Some black Paper
- \* PVA glue
- \* White tissue paper - optional - as these lanterns can be covered in tissue paper or cling film or both - see no 8.

### Instructions.....

1. Gather the longest 3 sticks into a point, and stick together with masking tape.
2. Place them in an upright position, like a tripod, and spread the feet apart at the base



3. Continue attaching the other three sticks around the base with masking tape securing them well together.

4. Attach the wire or twine to the top point for a hanging loop.

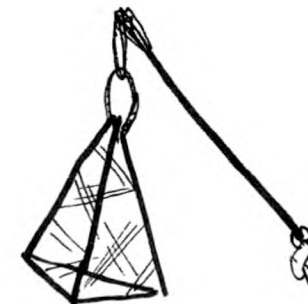
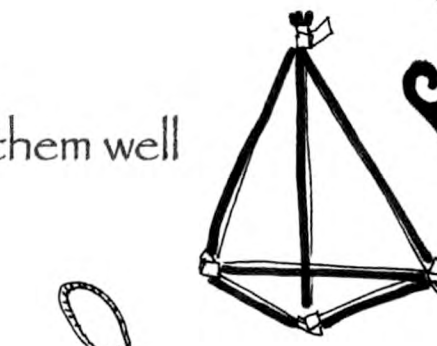
5. When pyramid shape is complete, wrap the cling film around the shape including the base, making sure to leave the wire or twine hoop hanging out from the top.

6. Put some cello-tape over the cling-film to strengthen and secure the structure better.

7. Tape some wire or twine to the long carry stick, and tie it together to the hanging loop on top of the Pyramid.

8. Apply the white tissue over the cling film using PVA Glue, covering the Pyramid completely.

9. Decorate using black paper cut into star shapes and stick on using PVA or cello-tape.



10. Inserting battery tea light or Glow stick....

Ask an Adult to help make a small incision at the top of the Pyramid using a scissors, when this is done - turn on the battery tea-light or snap the glow stick on and pop in. If the incision is cut too big, seal it up using cello-tape.
